You are **REQUIRED** to clean up after your dog at all of these motels. All dogs should be aired on lead. **DO NOT** leave dogs unattended inside motel rooms. Please crate your dogs while in motel rooms. The future for using these motels for all Dog Sports is in your hands. **PLEASE** do not damage any motel rooms or their surrounding areas. WAIT LIST FOR WITHDRAWN ENTRIES

After the closing date, FKC is offering a Wait List to fill openings created by withdrawn entries after closing. A maximum of 25 entries will be placed on the wait list. All entries including wait listed entries must be received by the Trial Secretary prior to October 19, 2011 6PM. Any entries withdrawn prior to October 31, 2011 at 6PM, will be replaced by a wait list entry when available, a full refund will be given to withdrawn entries when wait listed entries are available to replace the pulled entry. Any wait list entry that does not move off the wait list into the trial by October 31, 2011 6PM will receive a full refund.

There is a waiting list for this trial.

REGARDING THE TRIAL and AKC MEASUREMENTS...

This Trial is held under American Kennel Club Rules and Regulations.

Effective January 1, 2010, exhibitors are no longer required to provide proof to Trial Secretaries that their dog has a valid jump height card as part of the check-in process. Furthermore, this change eliminates the need for a copy of the jump height card to be submitted with an entry form. Dogs without a valid Jump Height Card/Form may still compete; but they must be measured/wicketed by the **Judge of Record** PRIOR to running in their class and this measurement will be valid for that weekend of trials only. The exception to this requirement is a dog entered in the 24" or 26" height division. However, if a **Volunteer Measuring Official (VMO)** or an **Agility Field Rep** is present; **ALL** dogs without a valid Jump Height Card/Form must be measured at some time during the trial or cluster of trials. This does not preclude having the dog wicketed by the Judge of Record if the VMO or Rep is not available to measure the dog **before** its first run of the trial or cluster of trials. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog measured prior to running and failure to do so will result in the cancellation of any qualifying scores. There will be multiple VMOs present at this trial.

All exhibitors must check in before judging of your first class on the first day you are entered. Self Check-in will be filed by handler name.

MOVE-UPS

It is the option of the club to allow day-to-day move-ups. Exhibitors should refer to a club's premium list to verify the club's policy for moving a dog up. If offered, dogs shall be moved up to a higher class at the request of the owner, as a result of the dog qualifying for an agility title.

The request for moving up must be made to the Trial Secretary according to the club's published policy. All move-up entries are subject to availability of the class and payment of any difference in entry fee. Dogs so moved-up will be entered at the end of the running order. Refer to Chapter 1, Section 20 of the Regulations for Agility Trials for additional move-up requirements. Move-ups prior to a set of trials: Dogs shall be moved up to a higher class at the request of the owner, as a result of qualifying for an agility title, provided that the request is made in writing to the Trial Secretary not later than 6:00 p.m. on the Monday preceding the set of trials for trials starting on a Thursday-Sunday. The request for moving up must be made in writing at the trial site to the Trial Secretary no later than the day preceding the event. Regulations for Agility Trials, Chapter 1, Section 20, (Amended September 1, 2011.)

Move-Up entries for Saturday, November 5, 2011 will be accepted for dogs that have completed a title after the closing date October 19, 2011. Email notification of move ups is acceptable, with return receipt verification from the secretary. Either Move Up forms or emails must be completed and delivered to the Trial Secretary prior to 6:00 PM, October 31, 2011. Day-to-day trial move-up entries for Sunday, November 6, 2011 must be delivered to the Trial Secretary at the trial site, within 30 minutes of the conclusion of judging on Saturday, November 5, 2011 at the trial site. Regulations for Agility Trials, Chapter 1, Section 21, "(Effective June 1, 2010.) A dog which has been entered in a Novice "A" class for which it is not eligible to be entered in due to class restrictions on the dog or handler may be moved to the Novice "B" class under the following conditions: The request for the move must be in writing and presented to the superintendent or the trial secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of each trial." Dogs moved up will run at the end of the running order.

A concession service will be on site.
