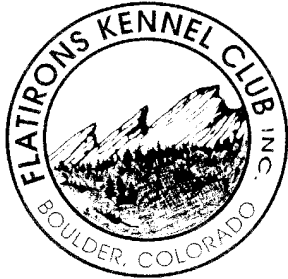

Go to the AKC Agility Online Entry Services home page at www.akc.org/AgilityEntry and follow the instructions there to use your My AKC account to enter this event online. During the first 48 hours after opening, the initial limit of entries designated as either online or paper will be as follows: 130 online entries and 530 paper entries. If either form of entry (paper or online) has not filled at the end of the 48 hour time period, the club reserves the right to decrease or increase either one accordingly.

E-mail confirmations will be sent to those listing a legible e-mail address on the entry form.

Please make checks payable to FLATIRONS KENNEL CLUB (FKC) No entries will be accepted by phone, fax or hand delivery. Express mail entries must include the signature waiver allowing them to be left at the secretary's address. Inquiries may be directed to Deb Ascher at LinkoutTS@aol.com. No entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any conditions as to its acceptance.

Illegible entries will not be processed and will be returned to the exhibitor. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry and the Trial Secretary will add a \$25.00 collection fee to the amount of each returned check.

No hand deliveries will be accepted in the first twenty-four hours following the opening date and time.

WAIT LIST FOR WITHDRAWN ENTRIES

After the closing date, FKC is offering a Wait List to fill openings created by withdrawn entries after closing. A maximum of 25 entries will be placed on the wait list. All entries including wait listed entries must be received by the Trial Secretary prior to October 19, 2011 6PM. Any entries withdrawn prior to October 31, 2011 at 6PM, will be replaced by a wait list entry when available, a full refund will be given to withdrawn entries when wait listed entries are available to replace the pulled entry. Any wait list entry that does not move off the wait list into the trial by October 31, 2011 6PM will receive a full refund.

MOVE UPS

Move-Up entries for Saturday, November 5, 2011 will be accepted for dogs that have completed a title after the closing date October 19, 2011. Email notification of move ups is acceptable, with return receipt verification from the secretary. Either Move Up forms or emails must be completed and delivered to the Trial Secretary prior to 6:00 PM, October 31, 2011. Day-to-day trial move-up entries for Sunday, November 6, 2011 must be delivered to the Trial Secretary at the trial site, within 30 minutes of the conclusion of judging on Saturday, November 5, 2011 at the trial site. Regulations for Agility Trials, Chapter 1, Section 21, "(Effective June 1, 2010.) A dog which has been entered in a Novice "A" class for which it is not eligible to be entered in due to class restrictions on the dog or handler may be moved to the Novice "B" class under the following conditions: The request for the move must be in writing and presented to the superintendent or the trial secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of each trial." Dogs moved up will run at the end of the running order.

HEIGHT DIVISIONS

Effective January 1, 2010, exhibitors are no longer required to provide proof to Trial Secretaries that their dog has a valid jump height card as part of the check-in process. Furthermore, this change eliminates the need for a copy of the jump height card to be submitted with an entry form. Dogs without a valid Jump Height Card/Form may still compete; but they must be measured/wicketed by the **Judge of Record** PRIOR to running in their class and this measurement will be valid for that weekend of trials only. The exception to this requirement is a dog entered in the 24" or 26" height division. However, if a **Volunteer Measuring Official (VMO)** or an **Agility Field Rep** is present; **ALL** dogs without a valid Jump Height Card/Form must be measured at some time during the trial or cluster of trials. This does not preclude having the dog wicketed by the Judge of Record if the VMO or Rep is not available to measure the dog **before** its first run of the trial or cluster of trials. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog measured prior to running and failure to do so will result in the cancellation of any qualifying scores.

OBSTACLES

Obstacles will meet the specifications for obstacles in the current edition of the Regulations for Agility Trials. All classes will take place indoors on a dirt surface. This trial will be held indoors, in two 90' x 95' dirt rings, run concurrently.

COURSE FAMILIARIZATION & TIMING

Handlers in all classes are permitted to walk the course, without a dog, during a walk-through period held prior to the start of the class. The walk-through is restricted to handlers entered in that class only. Handlers with multiple dogs, at events with multiple rings may request to walk with a height group other than the one their dog is entered in if a conflict is imminent.

A warm-up area, consisting of a regulation agility jump, may be provided for exhibitors. The warm-up area is to be used exclusively for warming up the dog and not for training or relieving of the dog. Umbrellas are not allowed on the course during the walk thru. Electronic timing devices may be used.

AWARDS

Placement rosettes will be awarded for the first through fourth place in each height division of each class for Standard Agility Classes and Jumpers with Weaves classes.

A green qualifying ribbon will be given to all qualifying dogs.
 Dogs must receive a qualifying score to receive placement awards.

ROUTES TO THE TRIAL

FROM THE NORTH and SOUTH: I-25 to Colorado Hwy 119 (Exit 240). Proceed west on Hwy 119, approximately 7.5 miles. Turn right on Nelson Rd. Go approximately 4/10 mile to first fairgrounds entry on right, into the fairgrounds.

EXHIBITOR INFORMATION

SAFETY, BEHAVIOR and LIABILITY

The safety of the dog is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.

It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create an unnecessary disturbance or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the trial committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made. The Flatirons Kennel Club and its agents, employees, etc., will assume no responsibilities for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors or handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children. The Flatirons Kennel Club reserves the right to decline entries for cause and may remove any dog on account of aggression. No one shall have any recourse or claim against the Flatirons Kennel Club or any official thereof.

All dogs must be on leash at all times when on trial grounds except when in the designated warm-up area or competing on the course.

All regulations governing the use of this facility, and all regulations and decisions of the trial committee at this trial will be strictly enforced, including and not limited to the recorded information of this premium list.

Puppies under 6 months of age are prohibited at AKC Agility Trials.

This club does not agree to arbitrate claims as set forth on the Official AKC entry form for this event.

ENTRY ELIGIBILITY

Breeds Eligible: All AKC-Recognized Breeds & Dogs Enrolled in the AKC Canine Partners Program

This trial is open to all dogs fifteen (15) months of age and older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners listing number (in trials offering mixed breed entries), or approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds are eligible to participate.

Dogs with a Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners listing number (in trials allowing mixed breed entries) must be spayed or neutered in order to compete. Wherever the word "dog" is used in these regulations it includes both sexes.

Dogs should be physically sound. Dogs that are blind or deaf shall not be eligible, and neither are bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance. No dog shall compete if it is taped or bandaged in any way or has anything attached to it for medical purposes. Refer to Chapter 2 of the Registration and Discipline Rules for the listing of registerable breeds that may participate. Puppies under six months of age are strictly prohibited from the trial grounds. Unentered dogs may be asked to leave the trial grounds.

REFUNDS

No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee. No entry fee will be refunded in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by the action of the Trial Committee.

Bitches in season are not permitted to compete in AKC Agility Trials. As such, the club will refund a portion of the paid fees per day of the entry fee paid for bitches unable to compete for this reason upon presentation of a veterinarian certificate. This certificate must be presented to the Trial Secretary prior to the start of judging on the first day of the trial or cluster of trials. A \$10.00/ entered day recording fee will be withheld for entries withdrawn due to a bitch being reported in season.

RINGSIDE

Dogs may arrive any time prior to judging, if a valid copy of their jump height card was sent with their entry. Otherwise, they must be available for measuring prior to the start of their class. All dogs not needed for further judging will be excused.

Judges are not required to wait for dogs. The Owner of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at ringside when it is to be judged. The Club has no responsibility for providing service through a public address system or stewards or runners for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought into the ring when required. Exhibitors may bring their own chairs, but due to space constraints, seating may be restricted. Food will be available for purchase.

Please keep dogs away from horses at all times.

CRATING and SEATING

Crating will be restricted to Barn A for exhibitors. There is limited crating in the Arena for workers and handicapped exhibitors. **Mats used under crates must match the dimensions of the crate. Excess matting will not be allowed.** Please be prepared to stack crates. **Barn A will be available for set up on Friday, from Noon – 3:00 PM, and during the trial hours.**

PARKING

Please adhere to all area parking regulations.

PLEASE NOTE: A limited number of handicap spaces are available. They will be available on a first-come basis. A valid handicap plate must be on each vehicle using these spaces. THESE SPACES WILL NOT ACCOMMODATE MOTOR HOMES.

CATALOGS

Advance catalog sales may be ordered and prepaid on your entry form for \$5.00. A limited number of catalogs will be available at the trial for purchase. Running order sheets will be available to all exhibitors at no charge.

VENDORS

No vendors will be allowed at this trial. A massage therapist will be in attendance.

DOGS MUST BE ON LEAD AT ALL TIMES OR CONFINED TO A CRATE OR EXERCISE PEN, EXCEPT WHEN COMPETING, OR WITHIN THE WARM-UP RING AREA.

It is the option of the club to allow day-to-day move-ups. Exhibitors should refer to a club's premium list to verify the club's policy for moving a dog up. If offered, dogs shall be moved up to a higher class at the request of the owner, as a result of the dog qualifying for an agility title.

The request for moving up must be made to the Trial Secretary according to the club's published policy. All move-up entries are subject to availability of the class and payment of any difference in entry fee. Dogs so moved-up will be entered at the end of the running order. Refer to Chapter 1, Section 20 of the Regulations for Agility Trials for additional move-up requirements. Move-ups prior to a set of trials: Dogs shall be moved up to a higher class at the request of the owner, as a result of qualifying for an agility title, provided that the request is made in writing to the Trial Secretary not later than 6:00 p.m. on the Monday preceding the set of trials for trials starting on a Thursday-Sunday. The request for moving up must be made in writing at the trial site to the Trial Secretary no later than the day preceding the event. Regulations for Agility Trials, Chapter 1, Section 20, (Amended September 1, 2011.)

Move-Up entries for Saturday, November 5, 2011 will be accepted for dogs that have completed a title after the closing date October 19, 2011. Email notification of move ups is acceptable, with return receipt verification from the secretary. Either Move Up forms or emails must be completed and delivered to the Trial Secretary prior to 6:00 PM, October 31, 2011. Day-to-day trial move-up entries for Sunday, November 6, 2011 must be delivered to the Trial Secretary at the trial site, within 30 minutes of the conclusion of judging on Saturday, November 5, 2011 at the trial site. 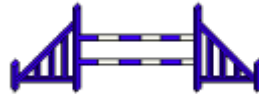
