Obedience Entry Fee: \$25.00 for the first entry of each dog (including 50 cent AKC recording fee and a \$3.00 event service fee) entered in obedience each day and \$17.00 for each additional entry of the same dog (including a \$3.00 event service fee for each additional entry of the same dog in the titling single entry classes) in all AKC licensed and member club events.

Rally Entry Fee: \$25.00 for the first entry of each dog and \$17.00 for each additional entry (including 50 cent AKC recording fee and a \$3.00 event service fee) entered in rally each day in all AKC licensed and member club events.

Please consult the AKC Regulations for Obedience Trials and/or Rally Trials for a complete description and eligibility for entry into these classes. Descriptions of the non-regular classes are in Chapter 10 of the Obedience Regulations. The exhibitor is fully responsible for entering the dog in the correct class(es)/height divisions.

ROUTES TO THE TRIAL



FROM THE NORTH - Take I-25 to Colorado 66 (Exit 243). West on 66 to Hover Rd (approximately 8 miles). South on Hover Rd to Nelson Rd (approximately 3 ½ miles). East on Nelson Rd to **second left** into Fairgrounds.

FROM THE SOUTH - Take I-25 to Colorado 52 (Exit 235). West on 52, also marked Mineral Rd (approximately 8 miles) to 95th St (3rd stop light). North on 95th St (Hover Rd) to Nelson Rd (approximately 5 miles). East on Nelson Rd to **second left** into Fairgrounds

MOVE-UPS

Obedience and Rally move-ups will be accepted as space permits, in accordance with Chapter 1, **Section 16a. Move-ups** of the Obedience Regulations. Requests for move-ups must be made in writing and presented to the trial secretary at least 30 minutes before the start of each trial.

- After a dog earns a title, it may be moved up to the next class in a future trial even though the closing date for the trial has passed, provided the club offers move-ups.
 - Move-ups may be approved, provided the next level class (e. g. Novice to Open) and judge is available and the class has not reached its limit.
 - A move-up may be requested if, according to the owner's records, the dog has completed the requirements for the title after the closing date of the trial in which the advanced entry is to be made.
 - The request for a move-up must be in writing and presented to the superintendent or trial secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of each trial.
 - Movement between an "A" and "B" class at the same level is not considered a move-up.
- Section 16b. Entry of Ineligible Dog.** A dog which has been entered in an "A" class for which it is not eligible to be entered in due to class restrictions on the dog or handler may be moved to the "B" class at the same level under the following conditions:
- The request for the move must be in writing and presented to the superintendent or trial secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of each trial.
 - The request must state the reason and justification for the move from an "A" class to the "B" class within the level.

In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made. The Flatirons Kennel Club and its agents, employees, etc., will assume no responsibilities for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors or handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children. The Flatirons Kennel Club reserves the right to decline entries for cause and may remove any dog on account of aggression. No one shall have any recourse or claim against the Flatirons Kennel Club or any official thereof.

All dogs must be on leash at all times when on trial grounds except when competing. All regulations governing the use of this facility, and all regulations and decisions of the trial committee at this trial will be strictly enforced, including and not limited to the recorded information of this premium list.

Unentered dogs are not allowed at this trial.

Puppies under 6 months of age are prohibited at AKC Obedience Trials or Rally Trials. Selling of Puppies at Any AKC Trial is STRICTLY forbidden.

NO STROLLERS ARE ALLOWED IN ANY BUILDING!! This is for the safety of your child & will be enforced.

Boulder County does not permit smoking in any County facility.

This club does not agree to arbitrate claims as set forth on the Official AKC entry form for this event.

WAIVER OF RIGHTS

THE CLUB RESERVES THE RIGHT TO REMOVE ANY ANIMAL IN DISTRESS FROM A PARKED VEHICLE OR CRATE & ALL PERSONS ATTENDING THESE DOG TRIALS HEREBY WAIVE ANY CLAIM FOR ANY DAMAGES THAT RESULT FROM SUCH ACTIONS.

DO NOT LEAVE A DOG IN A CLOSED VEHICLE!

ENTRY ELIGIBILITY

This trial is open to all dogs six (6) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP), an AKC Canine Partners listing number, or approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds are eligible to participate. Dogs with a Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners listing number must be spayed or neutered in order to compete. Wherever the word "dog" is used in these regulations it includes both sexes. Fees must accompany entries.

Dogs should be physically sound. Dogs that are blind or deaf shall not be eligible, and neither are bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance. No dog shall compete if it is taped or bandaged in any way or has anything attached to it for medical purposes. Refer to Chapter 2 of the Registration and Discipline Rules for the listing of registerable breeds that may participate. Puppies under six months of age are strictly prohibited from the trial grounds.

REFUNDS

No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee. No entry fee will be refunded in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by the action of the Trial Committee.

Bitches in season are not permitted to compete in Obedience or Rally Trials. As such, the club will refund a portion of the paid fees per day of the entry fee paid for bitches unable to compete for this reason upon presentation of a veterinarian certificate. This certificate must be presented to the Trial Secretary prior to the start of judging on the first day of the trial or cluster of trials. A \$10.00 per entered day recording fee will be withheld for entries withdrawn due to a bitch being reported in season.

RINGSIDE

Dogs may arrive any time prior to judging. Judges are not required to wait for dogs. The Owner of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at ringside when it is to be judged. The Club has no responsibility for providing service through a public address system or stewards or runners for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought into the ring when required. Exhibitors may bring their own chairs, but due to space constraints, seating may be restricted. Availability of food will be announced in the judging program.

Please keep dogs away from horses at all times.

CRATING and SEATING

Crating will be restricted to outside the ring area. There will be indoor crating area available at the show grounds, but crating space is not guaranteed. The Show Site Committee reserves the right to alter crating arrangements for space purposes. Exhibitors are responsible for the conditions in and around their own crate. No dogs will be permitted to stay overnight at the show site. X-pens are not allowed. Chairs are not provided. Mats used under crates must match the dimensions of the crate. Excess matting will not be allowed. Please be prepared to stack crates.

- A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his/her name. 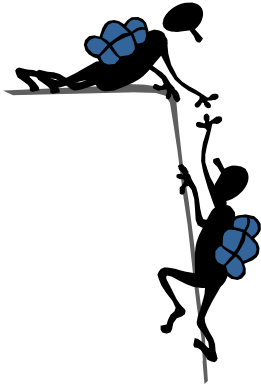
