JUDGING TO COMMENCE AT 8:00 AM SATURDAY & SUNDAY

We are pleased to be coming back to this fabulous facility! There are some special concerns to the use of their facility. Please be respectful of any special requests that are made for the use of this site. With your help, we will be able to come back to this site for future events!

We will be running agility on the indoor soccer field. There are also 3 indoor volleyball courts that have special flooring. We will be protecting this flooring with blue tarps. Only soft sided crates or plastic crates positioned on owner/handler provided clean matting (e.g., woven plastic crate mats, plastic grass mats or the like) will be allowed in this area. Folding chairs with protective feet (no bare metal feet) can be used in this area when placed on owner/handler provided grass mats.

There is limited crating available on cement to one side (east) of the arena. Xpens and wire crates will be allowed to be placed in this area only. Indoor crating space is not guaranteed.

There is also a grass area on a slight slope on the north side of the building that remains in the shade all day. Canopies and crating will be allowed in this area.

The building will be open for exhibitors set up during trial hours only. There will be NO advance set up time.

Parking in the Fire lane in front of Arena Sports or the NOCO ice arena is not allowed. Do not leave your vehicle unattended in this fire lane. Vehicles may be ticket if left unattended.

A catering service will be on site with a wide assortment of foods available for purchase.

From Denver:

Take I-25 North toward Fort Collins. Take the Windsor Exit (Exit 262) to Hwy 392, also known as Carpenter Road. Turn right and go east on Hwy 392 about 0.4 miles to County Road 5, also known as Fairgrounds Rd. It is a stoplight street. Turn right and go south on County Road 5/Fairgrounds Rd about 0.4 miles. The first building you see to the east is the Rural Electric Assoc'n Bldg. The 2nd building you will see on the east is Arena Sports. It is a long, white barrack-like building, with green awnings over pretend windows. Turn left onto the service road at the south end of the building. Go to the parking lots located to the east of Arena. (Mapquest gives incorrect directions, if you are planning on using Mapquest for your driving needs).

MOVE-UPS

Move-Up entries for Saturday, August 27, 2011 will be accepted for dogs that have completed a title after the closing date. Email notification of move ups is acceptable, with return receipt verification from the secretary. Either Move Up forms or emails must be completed and delivered to the Trial Secretary prior to 6:00 PM, August 22, 2011. Move-up entries for Sunday, August 28, 2011 must be delivered to the Trial Secretary at the trial site, within 30 minutes of the conclusion of judging on Saturday, August 27, 2011 at the trial site. A dog which has been entered in a Novice "A" class for which it is not eligible to be entered in due to class restrictions on the dog or handler may be moved to the Novice "B" class under the following conditions: The request for the move must be in writing and presented to the superintendent or trial secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of each trial. The request must state the reason and justification for the move from a Novice "A" class to the Novice "B" class. Dogs moved up will run at the end of the running order.

REGARDING THE TRIAL and AKC MEASUREMENTS...

All exhibitors must check in before judging of your first class on the first day you are entered. Arm bands will be available by self-check in for all dogs/handlers indicated their dogs had permanent height cards on their entry form. All dogs competing in agility must have a valid AKC Official Jump Height Card or form. If the dog does not have a valid Jump Height Card or form it must be measured by a VMO, AKC Field Representative or by the judge(s) of record before it runs. There will be ONE VMO present at this trial.

The following is the procedure for dogs that have not been measured by a VMO or Field Rep:

- If a VMO or Field Rep. is available, the dog should be measured before it runs. This will start the process toward getting a dog an AKC Jump Height Card.
- If a VMO or Field Rep. can not measure the dog before it runs, then the judge(s) of record needs to measure the dog prior to running. This measurement will only be effective for that set of trials.
- Dogs will no longer need to be measured by a judge of record if the handler has a valid height card or 2 valid yellow height card form(s) in their possession.

Official measurements after a dog runs:

If a VMO or Field Rep. measures a dog after it runs and this measurement changes the jump height it is in, the measurement is effective the next day and for all future trials. If this occurs, keep in mind the following:

- If this measurement would move the dog to a higher jump height in the Regular Classes, this would also happen on the next day or trial in which the dog is entered. If the height would move the dog to a lower jump height, the dog would only be allowed to move down into that jump height at the next trial in which the dog is entered if that trial has not closed.
- If the dog is entered in the Preferred Classes, and the measurement from the VMO or AKC Field Rep. would change the jump height either up or down, this change is effective immediately for all trials in which the dog is entered regardless of whether or not the trial has met the closing date for entries.

Dogs may arrive anytime prior to their scheduled time of judging. Dogs not required for further judging will be excused. Exhibitors are responsible for being at the ring when it is their turn to run. Exhibitors are required to wear the provided armbands.

Judges are not required to wait for dogs. They will adhere, as closely as possible, to the judging schedule. The owner of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at ringside when it is to be judged. The trial giving club and the trial secretary have no obligation or responsibility for providing service, through a public address system, or stewards, or runners, for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are to be at ring side when required.
