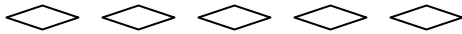

Rally Entry Fee: \$25.00 for the first entry of each dog and \$20.00 for each additional entry (including a recording fee of \$3.00 for each entry of each dog) entered in rally each day in all AKC licensed and member club events. The entry fee also includes the Island Grove Regional Park daily per dog fee of \$1.50. This revenue will go towards capital improvements to the park.

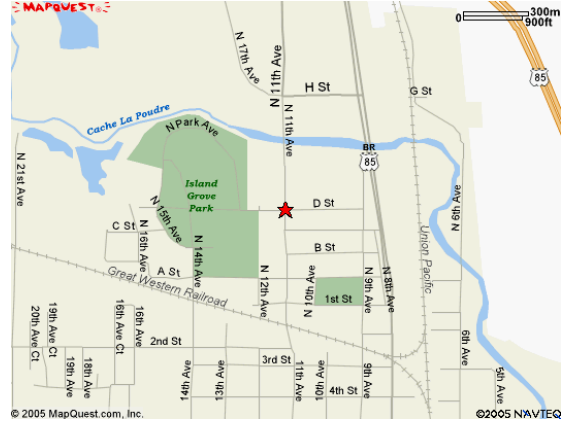

SPECIAL ATTRACTION CLASS: GREAT BEGINNINGS

A non-regular class. The purpose of this class is to provide exercises which are fun for both the dog and handler. The intent is that this class will have a practical purpose towards advanced classes as well as household obedience. It is hoped that this class will be enjoyable for both spectators and participants.

Class is open to any dog entered in another class, no title limitations or prerequisites. Dog may be handled by owner or any other person. Any AKC Obedience judge Provisional Non-Reg and beyond may judge this class.

All exercises performed off lead.

Heel Free 40 points Team performs pattern of their choice. There are no orders from the judge. When Handler states "Ready" scoring begins. Team will heel as they choose using most of the ring area, up to a five point deduction for poor ring use. Two halts are required, they may take place during the pattern, simply releasing at the end, or one during the pattern and one at the end as is traditionally done. There are no other required elements; handlers may choose any speed, turns, or loops as they wish. Extra verbal commands are not penalized in any way, body English and all other aspects of the heelwork is scored as in traditional Obedience classes. The heeling pattern should last between 25 and 35 seconds. Timed by a steward from "ready" to a clear release, a one point deduction per second over or under 25/35 limits, rounded in the teams favor.

Retrieve 40 points Performed as the Retrieve on the Flat except that: Any object of the handlers choosing may be used provided the item does not roll or travel on landing. Squeaking items are allowed; with that, it must be noted that dogs will be penalized for mouthing (and squeaking) said item; a minimum of a three point deduction will be taken for each individual "squeak". The item must be thrown a distance greater than ten feet.

Single Signal Exercise 40 points Handler's choice. Handler will state the dogs starting and ending position; possibilities include but are not limited to: stand to down, down to sit, stand to sit, etc. not to include the recall signal. Handler will leave dog in a manner consistent with the regulations on the Group Exercises. Handler will proceed ten feet or more, turn and face dog, on judges signal the handler will signal dog to change position which will be scored as in the Signal Exercise. On judges order handler returns as he/she would in the group exercises being scored as such.

Tunnel Recall 40 points Scored as the Novice Recall except that dog must travel through tunnel. Handler may use a "tunnel" and a "front" command as well as an additional "front" command when the dog exits the tunnel on route to the handler. Failure to travel through tunnel on route to handler results in a 20 point deduction.

Pizza Stay 40 points Dog is positioned in designated location as in the Group Exercises. Following the handlers command and/or signal to "stay" a Steward shall approach the entrance gate with pizza (described below) and audibly state "Pizza Delivery." The handler will meet the steward at a point and location convenient to them and take possession of the pizza. The handler will take said pizza and place it on the chair located between 10 and 15 feet from the dog, handler then returns to dog as in group exercises. This will be scored as the Group Exercises except that extra commands, verbal or otherwise will be a five point deduction per command. Judge and steward will demo or walk through this exercise prior to the class.

Total possible 200 points

Misc. Tunnel is weighted for safety, it will be a 15 ft. tunnel meeting the AKC agility tunnel specifications. Pizza will be actual pizza placed in a Rally bowl to ensure a dog does not eat the pizza.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

SAFETY, BEHAVIOR and LIABILITY

It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create an unnecessary disturbance or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the trial committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made. The Longs Peak Dog Training Club and its agents, employees, etc., will assume no responsibilities for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors or handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children. The Longs Peak Dog Training Club reserves the right to decline entries for cause and may remove any dog on account of aggression. No one shall have any recourse or claim against the Longs Peak Dog Training Club or any official thereof.

All dogs must be on leash at all times when on trial grounds except when competing.

All regulations governing the use of this facility, and all regulations and decisions of the trial committee at this trial will be strictly enforced, including and not limited to the recorded information of this premium list.

Puppies under 6 months of age are prohibited at AKC Obedience Trials or Rally Trials.

This club does not agree to arbitrate claims as set forth on the Official AKC entry form for this event.

ENTRY ELIGIBILITY

This trial is open to all dogs six (6) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP), an AKC Canine Partners listing number, or approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds are eligible to participate. Dogs with a Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners listing number must be spayed or neutered in order to compete. Wherever the word "dog" is used in these regulations it includes both sexes. Fees must accompany entries.

Dogs should be physically sound. Dogs that are blind or deaf shall not be eligible, and neither are bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance. No dog shall compete if it is taped or bandaged in any way or has anything attached to it for medical purposes. Refer to Chapter 2 of the Registration and Discipline Rules for the listing of registerable breeds that may participate. Puppies under six months of age are strictly prohibited from the trial grounds.

REFUNDS

No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee. No entry fee will be refunded in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by the action of the Trial Committee.

Bitches in season are not permitted to compete in Obedience or Rally Trials. As such, the club will refund a portion of the paid fees per day of the entry fee paid for bitches unable to compete for this reason upon presentation of a veterinarian certificate. This certificate must be presented to the Trial Secretary prior to the start of judging on the first day of the trial or cluster of trials. A \$10.00 per entered day recording fee will be withheld for entries withdrawn due to a bitch being reported in season.

CATALOGS

RINGSIDE

Dogs may arrive any time prior to judging. Judges are not required to wait for dogs. The Owner of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at ringside when it is to be judged. The Club has no responsibility for providing service through a public address system or stewards or runners for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought into the ring when required. Exhibitors may bring their own chairs, but due to space constraints, seating may be restricted.

CRATING and SEATING

Crating will be restricted to outside the ring area. There will be indoor crating area available at the show grounds, but crating space is not guaranteed. The Show Site Committee reserves the right to alter crating arrangements for space purposes. Exhibitors are responsible for the conditions in and around their own crate. No dogs will be permitted to stay overnight at the show site.

X-pens may not be allowed. Individual chair seating may not be allowed, if space prohibits. Mats used under crates must match the dimensions of the crate. Excess matting will not be allowed. Please be prepared to stack crates.

VENDORS

MOVE-UPS

Obedience and Rally move-ups will be accepted as space permits, in accordance with Chapter 1, **Section 16a. Move-ups** of the Obedience Regulations. Requests for move-ups must be made in writing and presented to the trial secretary at least 30 minutes before the start of each trial.

- After a dog earns a title, it may be moved up to the next class in a future trial even though the closing date for the trial has passed, provided the club offers move-ups.
- Move-ups may be approved, provided the next level class (e. g. Novice to Open) and judge is available and the class has not reached its limit.
- A move-up may be requested if, according to the owner's records, the dog has completed the requirements for the title after the closing date of the trial in which the advanced entry is to be made.
- The request for a move-up must be in writing and presented to the superintendent or trial secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of each trial.
- Movement between an "A" and "B" class at the same level is not considered a move-up.

Section 16b. Entry of Ineligible Dog. A dog which has been entered in an "A" class for which it is not eligible to be entered in due to class restrictions on the dog or handler may be moved to the "B" class at the same level under the following conditions:

- The request for the move must be in writing and presented to the superintendent or trial secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of each trial.
- The request must state the reason and justification for the move from an "A" class to the "B" class within the level.

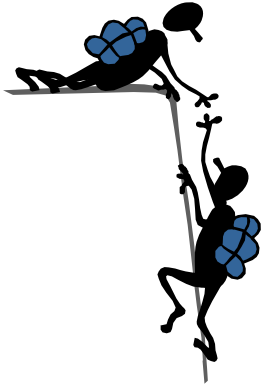
