BUILDING AVAILABILITY

Adams County Fairgrounds, 9755 Henderson Rd, Brighton, CO 80601

The building will be available for advanced set-up Thursday evening, from 7:00-8:00 PM ONLY. Only set up workers will be allowed into the building prior to 7:00 PM for set up. The building will open at 7:00 AM during the days of the trial. Trial hours are 7:00 AM – 7:00 PM all trial days.

CHECK-IN AND RING CONFLICTS

Arm bands will be available for self check in. If possible, Ring Gate Running Orders will be available at the same time. If space concerns prohibit this, check-in will occur at ring side before each class, each day. Any conflicts you anticipate must be resolved at ring side with the approval of the gate steward and judge. PLEASE do NOT move yourself in running order without the approval of these people. Exhibitors are solely responsible for having their dog at ringside and available for judging when it is their turn to run. Judges are not required to wait for dogs, nor allow runs by a competitor who missed their scheduled run.

CRATING

Crating will be restricted to outside the ring area. Priority for crating space will be given to trial volunteers. Please place crates close together to allow all exhibitors room to crate indoors. Mats will be allowed only IN x-pens. The show site committee reserves the right to alter the crating arrangements for space purposes. Indoor crating space is not guaranteed. Please be prepared to stack crates.

MOVE-UPS

Move-Up entries for Friday, October 7, 2011 will be accepted for dogs that have completed a title after the closing date September 14, 2011. Email notification of move ups is acceptable, with return receipt verification from the secretary. Either Move Up forms or emails must be completed and delivered to the Trial Secretary prior to 6:00 PM, October 3, 2011. Day-to-day trial move-up entries for Saturday, October 8, 2011 must be delivered to the Trial Secretary at the trial site, within 30 minutes of the conclusion of judging on Friday, October 7, 2011 at the trial site. Day-to-day trial move-up entries for Sunday, October 9, 2011 must be delivered to the Trial Secretary at the trial site, within 30 minutes of the conclusion of judging on Saturday, October 8, 2011 at the trial site. Regulations for Agility Trials, Chapter 1, Section 21, "(Effective June 1, 2010.) A dog which has been entered in a Novice "A" class for which it is not eligible to be entered in due to class restrictions on the dog or handler may be moved to the Novice "B" class under the following conditions: The request for the move must be in writing and presented to the superintendent or the trial secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of each trial." Dogs moved up will run at the end of the running order.

There is NO wait list for this trial. Post closing entry pulls are not available.

AT JUDGE'S OPTION, CLASSES WILL HAVE ADDITIONAL SPLIT WALK-THRU'S AND/OR RUNS SPECIFIC INSTRUCTIONS WILL BE GIVEN DURING THE JUDGE'S BRIEFING.

"B" class dogs will run prior to "A" class dogs in the Novice and Excellent classes, within height classifications, except where indicated otherwise. A warm-up area, consisting of a regulation agility jump, shall be provided for all exhibitors.

All ring conflicts will be handled as fairly as possible. Please let ring stewards know of any possible conflicts so that arrangements can be made for the necessary running order changes. The Standard Ring takes precedence for running. Please try to make changes to the running order in the Jumpers Ring to alleviate conflicts, when possible.

REGARDING THE TRIAL AND AKC MEASUREMENTS...

All exhibitors must check in before judging of your first class on the first day you are entered. Arm bands will be available by self-check in for all dogs/handlers whose AKC Height Card is on file with the trial secretary. All dogs competing in agility must have a valid AKC Official Jump Height Card or form. If the dog does not have a valid Jump Height Card or form it must be measured by a VMO, AKC Field Representative or by the judge(s) of record before it runs. There will be multiple VMOs present at this trial.

The following is the procedure for dogs that have not been measured by a VMO or Field Rep:

- If a VMO or Field Rep. is available, the dog should be measured before it runs. This will start the process toward getting a dog an AKC Jump Height Card.
- If a VMO or Field Rep. can not measure the dog before it runs, then the judge(s) of record needs to measure the dog prior to running. This measurement will only be effective for that set of trials.
- Dogs will no longer need to be measured by a judge of record if the handler has a valid height card or valid yellow height card form(s) in their possession.

Official measurements after a dog runs:

If a VMO or Field Rep. measures a dog after it runs and this measurement changes the jump height it is in, the measurement is effective the next day and for all future trials. If this occurs, keep in mind the following:

- If this measurement would move the dog to a higher jump height in the Regular Classes, this would also happen on the next day or trial in which the dog is entered. If the height would move the dog to a lower jump height, the dog would only be allowed to move down into that jump height at the next trial in which the dog is entered if that trial has not closed.
- If the dog is entered in the Preferred Classes, and the measurement from the VMO or AKC Field Rep. would change the jump height either up or down, this change is effective immediately for all trials in which the dog is entered regardless of whether or not the trial has met the closing date for entries.

Dogs may arrive anytime prior to their scheduled time of judging. Dogs not required for further judging will be excused. Exhibitors are responsible for being at the ring when it is their turn to run. Exhibitors are required to wear the provided armbands.

Judges are not required to wait for dogs. They will adhere, as closely as possible, to the judging schedule. The owner of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at ringside when it is to be judged. The trial giving club and the trial secretary have no obligation or responsibility for providing service, through a public address system, or stewards, or runners, for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are to be at ring side when required.
