Illegible entries will not be processed and will be returned to the exhibitor. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry and the Trial Secretary will add a \$25.00 collection fee to the amount of each returned check. Subsequent returned checks from the same exhibitors may result in their being put on a **CASH ONLY** basis.

If you would like to know the status of your entry prior to the issuance of the judging schedule upon closing, please enclose a self-addressed, stamped envelope or postcard along with your entry. E-mail preliminary and final confirmations will be sent to those listing a legible e-mail address on the entry form.

RANDOM DRAW

Due to the Random Draw Entry method, worker spaces will be held for a limited number of handlers by the trial committee. Those who wish to be considered for the workers' draw list must agree to work ½ day or more each day of the trial they have entered. If you are willing to be on the worker list, please include a volunteer form indicating worker status, noting what you would like to do. Those who volunteer and receive a designated spot, but do not fulfill their worker assignments during the trial will not be considered for future designated spots in Rocky Mountain All Terrier Club Random Draw Trials.

In compliance with Chapter 1, Section 16 of Regulations for Agility Trials, Rocky Mountain All Terrier Club establishes the policy that designated worker spots are allowed to handlers working 2 or fewer dogs during any day of the trial. Handlers entering/running more than 2 dogs will be placed in the Draw for entry spaces, and not considered for designated worker spots during this trial. Preference for designated worker spots will be given to those handlers entering all days of the trial, over a single days entries. Lunch will be provided for all workers.

All exhibitors supplying a legible and current email address will receive notification of entry receipt, and draw outcome after the Random Draw has been held and processed. All entry forms and payment checks that do not make the draw for the Trial will be placed on the waiting list for a spot until the closing date. Unless otherwise requested, all entries that do not make it into the Trial will be shredded.

WAIT LIST FOR WITHDRAWN ENTRIES

After the closing date, RMATC is offering a Wait List to fill openings created by withdrawn entries after closing. A maximum of 25 entries will be placed on the wait list. All entries including wait listed entries must be received by the Trial Secretary prior to **Wednesday, August 10, 2011 6:00 p.m. (MT)**. Any entries withdrawn prior to 6:00 PM, August 10, 2011 will be replaced by a wait list entry, a full refund will be given to withdrawn entries when wait listed entries are available to replace the pulled entry. Any wait list entry that does not move off the wait list into the trial by 6:00 PM, August 10, 2011 will receive a full refund.

HEIGHT DIVISIONS

Effective January 1, 2010, exhibitors are no longer required to provide proof to Trial Secretaries that their dog has a valid jump height card as part of the check-in process. Furthermore, this change eliminates the need for a copy of the jump height card to be submitted with an entry form. Dogs without a valid Jump Height Card/Form may still compete; but they must be measured/wicketed by the **Judge of Record** PRIOR to running in their class and this measurement will be valid for that weekend of trials only. The exception to this requirement is a dog entered in the 24" or 26" height division. However, if a **Volunteer Measuring Official (VMO)** or an **Agility Field Rep** is present; **ALL** dogs without a valid Jump Height Card/Form must be measured at some time during the trial or cluster of trials. This does not preclude having the dog wicketed by the Judge of Record if the VMO or Rep is not available to measure the dog *before* its first run of the trial or cluster of trials. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog measured prior to running and failure to do so will result in the cancellation of any qualifying scores.

NEW Simplified Jump Height Card Process

When filling out the entry form, there is a new section at the top of the form for exhibitors to designate whether your dog has a valid jump height card or if your dog needs to be measured. Please check the appropriate box so that the Trial Secretary knows whether to include your dog on the **Dogs To Be Measured List**. It is no longer required that you submit a copy of your dog's jump height card with your entry form or show it during day of show check-in.

MOVE UPS

Move-Up entries for Saturday, August 27, 2011 will be accepted for dogs that have completed a title after the closing date. Email notification of move ups is acceptable, with return receipt verification from the secretary. Either Move Up forms or emails must be completed and delivered to the Trial Secretary prior to 6:00 PM, August 22, 2011. Move-up entries for Sunday, August 28, 2011 must be delivered to the Trial Secretary at the trial site, within 30 minutes of the conclusion of judging on Saturday, August 27, 2011 at the trial site. A dog which has been entered in a Novice "A" class for which it is not eligible to be entered in due to class restrictions on the dog or handler may be moved to the Novice "B" class under the following conditions: The request for the move must be in writing and presented to the superintendent or trial secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of each trial. The request must state the reason and justification for the move from a Novice "A" class to the Novice "B" class. Dogs moved up will run at the end of the running order.

CRATING

The largest crating area will be on mats covering the volleyball courts. Only soft crates will be allowed to be used for crating in this area. Only soft sided crates or plastic crates positioned on owner/handler provided clean matting (e.g., woven plastic crate mats, plastic grass mats or the like) will be allowed in this area. Folding chairs with protective feet (no bare metal feet) can be used in this area when placed on owner/handler provided grass mats. There is limited crating space on concrete. All other crates (hard, metal and x-pens for multiple dogs, etc.) may be used in the concrete floor areas.

OBSTACLES

Obstacles will meet the specifications for obstacles in the current edition of the Regulations for Agility Trials. Weave poles spaced 24" will be used at these trials. All classes will take place indoors on a soccer-turf surface. Ring Measurement 120' x 85'.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

SAFETY, BEHAVIOR and LIABILITY

The safety of the dog is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely. It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create an unnecessary disturbance or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the trial committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made. The Rocky Mountain All Terrier Club and its agents, employees, etc., will assume no responsibilities for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors or handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children. The Rocky Mountain All Terrier Club reserves the right to decline entries for cause and may remove any dog on account of aggression. No one shall have any recourse or claim against the Rocky Mountain All Terrier Club or any official thereof.

All dogs must be on leash at all times when on trial grounds except when in the designated warm-up area or competing on the course.

All regulations governing the use of this facility, and all regulations and decisions of the trial committee at this trial will be strictly enforced, including and not limited to the recorded information of this premium list.

Puppies under 6 months of age are prohibited at AKC Agility Trials.

This club does not agree to arbitrate claims as set forth on the Official AKC entry form for this event.

ENTRY ELIGIBILITY

This trial is open to all dogs fifteen (15) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners listing number (in trials offering mixed breed entries-THIS TRIAL IS NOT ALLOW CANINE PARTNERS), or approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds are eligible to participate.

Dogs with a Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners listing number (in trials allowing mixed breed entries-THIS TRIAL IS NOT ALLOWING CANINE PARTNERS) must be spayed or neutered in order to compete. Wherever the word "dog" is used in these regulations it includes both sexes.

Dogs should be physically sound. Dogs that are blind or deaf shall not be eligible, and neither are bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance. No dog shall compete if it is taped or bandaged in any way or has anything attached to it for medical purposes. Refer to Chapter 2 of the Registration and Discipline Rules for the listing of registerable breeds that may participate. Puppies under six months of age are strictly prohibited from the trial grounds. Unentered dogs may be asked to leave the trial grounds.

REFUNDS

No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee. No entry fee will be refunded in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by the action of the Trial Committee.

Bitches in season are not permitted to compete in Agility Trials. As such, the club will refund a portion of the paid fees per day of the entry fee paid for bitches unable to compete for this reason upon presentation of a veterinarian certificate. This certificate must be presented to the Trial Secretary prior to the start of judging on the first day of the trial or cluster of trials. A \$7.50/entered day recording fee will be withheld for entries withdrawn due to a bitch being reported in season.

RINGSIDE

Dogs may arrive any time prior to judging, if a valid copy of their jump height card was sent with their entry. Otherwise, they must be available for measuring prior to the start of their class. All dogs not needed for further judging will be excused. Judges are not required to wait for dogs. The Owner of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at ringside when it is to be judged. The Club has no responsibility for providing service through a public address system or stewards or runners for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought into the ring when required. Exhibitors may bring their own chairs, but due to space constraints, seating may be restricted. Food will be available for purchase.

CRATING and SEATING

Crating will be restricted to outside the ring area. There will be crating area available at the show grounds, but Crating space is not guaranteed. The Show Site Committee reserves the right to alter crating arrangements for space purposes. Exhibitors are responsible for the conditions in and around their own crate. No dogs will be permitted to stay overnight at the show site.

Mats used under crates must at a minimum match the dimensions of the crate.

VENDORS

No vendor space is available at this location.

CATALOGS

Catalogs are available at the trial for \$5.00. Running order sheets will be available to all exhibitors at no charge.

A concession service will be on site.

It is the option of the club to allow day-to-day move-ups. Exhibitors should refer to a club's premium list to verify the club's policy for moving a dog up. If offered, dogs shall be moved up to a higher class at the request of the owner, as a result of the dog qualifying for an agility title. The request for moving up must be made to the Trial Secretary according to the club's published policy. All move-up entries are subject to availability of the class and payment of any difference in entry fee. Dogs so moved-up will be entered at the end of the running order. Refer to Chapter 1, Section 20 of the Regulations for Agility Trials for additional move-up requirements.

Move-Up entries for Saturday, August 27, 2011 will be accepted for dogs that have completed a title after the closing date. Email notification of move ups is acceptable, with return receipt verification from the secretary. Either Move Up forms or emails must be completed and delivered to the Trial Secretary prior to 6:00 PM, August 22, 2011. Move-up entries for Sunday, August 28, 2011 must be delivered to the Trial Secretary at the trial site, within 30 minutes of the conclusion of judging on Saturday, August 27, 2011 at the trial site. A dog which has been entered in a Novice "A" class for which it is not eligible to be entered in due to class restrictions on the dog or handler may be moved to the Novice "B" class under the following conditions: The request for the move must be in writing and presented to the superintendent or trial secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of each trial. The request must state the reason and justification for the move from a Novice "A" class to the Novice "B" class. Dogs moved up will run at the end of the running order.

Dogs listed in the AKC Canine PartnersSM program may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC agility trials at the club's option. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box.
