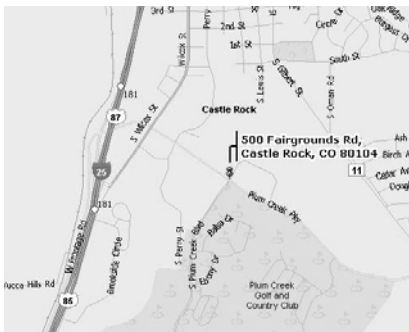

## NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

### SAFETY, BEHAVIOR and LIABILITY

The safety of the dog is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of these sports, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.

It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create an unnecessary disturbance or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the trial committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made. The ROCKY MOUNTAIN ALL TERRIER CLUB and its agents, employees, etc., will assume no responsibilities for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors or handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children. The ROCKY MOUNTAIN ALL TERRIER CLUB reserves the right to decline entries for cause and may remove any dog on account of aggression. No one shall have any recourse or claim against the ROCKY MOUNTAIN ALL TERRIER CLUB or any official thereof.

All dogs must be on leash at all times when on trial grounds except when in the designated warm-up area or competing on the course.

All regulations governing the use of this facility, and all regulations and decisions of the trial committee at this trial will be strictly enforced, including and not limited to the recorded information of this premium list.

Puppies under 6 months of age are prohibited at AKC Trials.

**This club does not agree to arbitrate claims as set forth on the Official AKC entry form for this event.**

### ENTRY ELIGIBILITY

This Obedience and Rally trial is open to all dogs in the Terrier Group over the age of 6 months that are registered with the American Kennel Club or are registerable breeds that have obtained an AKC ILP/PAL number. This agility trial is open to all dogs in the Terrier Group 15 months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners listing number (in trials offering mixed breed entries), or approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds are eligible to participate.

Dogs with a Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners listing number (in trials allowing mixed breed entries) must be spayed or neutered in order to compete. Wherever the word "dog" is used in these regulations it includes both sexes. THIS TRIAL IS LIMITED TO BREEDS WITHIN THE TERRIER GROUP ONLY.

Dogs should be physically sound. Dogs that are blind or deaf shall not be eligible, and neither are bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance. No dog shall compete if it is taped or bandaged in any way or has anything attached to it for medical purposes. Refer to Chapter 2 of the Registration and Discipline Rules for the listing of registerable breeds that may participate. Puppies under six months of age are strictly prohibited from the trial grounds.

### REFUNDS

No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee. No entry fee will be refunded in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by the action of the Trial Committee.

Bitches in season are not permitted to compete in Agility, Obedience or Rally Trials. As such, the club will refund a portion of the paid fees per day of the entry fee paid for bitches unable to compete for this reason upon presentation of a veterinarian certificate. This certificate must be presented to the Trial Secretary prior to the start of judging on the first day of the trial or cluster of trials. A \$10.00 per entered day recording fee will be withheld for entries withdrawn due to a bitch being reported in season.

### RINGSIDE

Dogs may arrive any time prior to judging. All dogs not needed for further judging will be excused.

Judges are not required to wait for dogs. The Owner of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at ringside when it is to be judged. The Club has no responsibility for providing service through a public address system or stewards or runners for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought into the ring when required. Exhibitors may bring their own chairs, but due to space constraints, seating may be restricted.

**Please keep dogs away from horses at all times.**

### CRATING and SEATING

Crating will be restricted to outside the ring area. There will be indoor crating area available at the show grounds, but crating space is not guaranteed. The Show Site Committee reserves the right to alter crating arrangements for space purposes. Exhibitors are responsible for the conditions in and around their own crate. No dogs will be permitted to stay overnight at the show site.

X-pens may not be allowed. Mats used under crates must match the dimensions of the crate. Excess matting will not be allowed. Please be prepared to stack crates. The Trial Committee reserves the right to regulate and rearrange crating arrangements.

Dogs are NOT allowed to be crated in the grand stand area, due to fire code regulations. Leased dogs in the grand stands must be accompanied by their owner/guardian. Tethering dogs is NOT allowed. Chairs are allowed on the concrete walk way for the grand stand area for handicapped individuals ONLY.

### PARKING

Exhibitors are governed by any rules or regulations of civil authorities and building and parking regulations. Vehicles parked contrary to regulations will be subject to towing at owner's expense.

PLEASE NOTE: A limited number of handicap spaces are available. They will be available on a first-come basis. A valid handicap plate must be on each vehicle using these spaces. Parking in front of building is limited to those with handicapped permits and unloading only. THESE SPACES WILL NOT ACCOMMODATE MOTOR HOMES.

Club officials may require that vehicles or equipment be rearranged to accommodate additional vehicles. Area around vehicles MUST be kept clean at all times. All vehicles will be parked at owner's risk. Douglas County Fairgrounds and Rocky Mountain All Terrier Club will not be responsible for loss by burglary, fire, or any other cause whatsoever to the vehicle or its contents.

## TOPS Awards Scoring Summary

The TOPS Awards are intended to recognize the most versatile and successful performing terriers. To celebrate these TOPS terriers, special awards will be given to the overall TOPS four terriers and the top terrier in each breed. These awards will be presented at the close of all competition on Sunday, at the end of the three days of agility, obedience, and rally.

The objective of the TOPS High in Summit (HIS) scoring system is to reward versatile terriers performing at the various levels of competition in the three different AKC venues (agility, obedience and rally). One of the challenges for developing a fair HIS scoring system is to balance the scores from the three venues such that each venue contributes to the HIS score in as equitable a fashion as possible.

We have revised our scoring in order to simplify its calculation from previous TOPS weekends. A summary of the new key elements of the scoring system is provided below:

Only qualifying scores will be included in the TOPS calculation. Points will not be subtracted for non-qualifying attempts, or absences.

For TOPS Breed awards non-qualifying scores will be included if there are no qualifying scores in a breed.

A maximum of 2 qualifying scores each from the regular titling classes in agility, obedience, and rally each day will be included in the TOPS calculation.

Scores from non-regular classes or optional titling classes (e.g. FAST, Grad Novice, etc.) will not count towards the TOPS Award except as needed for tiebreakers, and will not be weighted.

Obedience scores will be normalized to the same 100 pt scale used in rally and agility by dividing qualifying obedience scores by 2 (e.g., an obedience score of 196 would become 98)

Higher-level classes will be weighted more than lower classes.

Novice classes in obedience and agility, and rally excellent classes will be the baseline

Open obedience and agility scores will be multiplied by 1.5

Utility obedience and excellent agility scores will be multiplied by 2.

Rally classes, since it is "a link from the Canine Good Citizen® (CGC) program to obedience or agility competition," will be weighted at half the corresponding level of obedience and agility classes.

Rally Novice scores will be multiplied by 0.5

Rally Advanced scores will be multiplied by 0.75.

Rally Excellent scores will be multiplied by 1

In the event of a tie for an award, any qualifying scores from non-regular or optional titling classes will be included, and considered along with yards-per-second calculations from any agility Qs. The dog qualifying in the larger variety of venues/classes and/or at the higher level will be declared the winner.

Earthdog scores will NOT be included in the TOPS award calculations.

For example, a daily TOPS score for a Miniature Schnauzer entered in Excellent Standard and Jumpers agility, Open FAST agility, Rally Novice, and Open A and Grad Novice obedience, and qualifying in all but Excellent standard and Open FAST agility would be compiled as follows:

Breed: Mini Sch; Registration number: RM00000000

Name: Otto

Agility Std Excellent score: NQ so score of zero

Agility JWW Excellent score: 100 (x2 Excellent weighting factor) =200

Agility FAST Open score: NQ but if Q'ed, would only be considered for tiebreaker

Rally Novice score: 95 (x 0.5 Rally Novice weighting factor) = 47.5

Obedience Open A score: 180/2 = 90 (x1.5 Open weighting factor) = 135

Obedience Grad novice score: 192/2 =96 (but not counted except as needed for tiebreakers)

**TOTAL: 382.5 points**

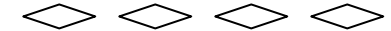

Effective January 1, 2010, exhibitors are no longer required to provide proof to Trial Secretaries that their dog has a valid jump height card as part of the check-in process. Furthermore, this change eliminates the need for a copy of the jump height card to be submitted with an entry form. Dogs without a valid Jump Height Card/Form may still compete; but they must be measured/wicketed by the **Judge of Record** PRIOR to running in their class and this measurement will be valid for that weekend of trials only. The exception to this requirement is a dog entered in the 24" or 26" height division. However, if a **Volunteer Measuring Official (VMO)** or an **Agility Field Rep** is present; **ALL** dogs without a valid Jump Height Card/Form must be measured at some time during the trial or cluster of trials.
